Foundations for Success is a five-year initiative designed to develop and implement a county-wide system for early childhood mental health services in Ramsey County. Funded by the John S. and James L. Knight Foundation and coordinated by the Community Action Partnership of Ramsey and Washington Counties, the initiative promotes culturally competent and family friendly services. Services are developed and implemented by a collaboration of more than 100 community agencies, representing local foundations, government, parents, school districts, health, mental health, early childhood professionals, and the University of Minnesota.

In the fall of 2005, Wilder Research invited 42 representatives from mental health agencies in Ramsey County to complete an online inventory of available services for children and their families. Due to a low initial response rate to the online survey, Wilder Research staff made follow-up calls to agencies early in 2006. In total, 28 respondents completed the survey. Of the 28 respondents, 24 indicated that they wished to be included in this directory.

This directory summarizes the mental health services available to children aged birth to five years in Ramsey County, as reported by these 24 agencies. As such, they do not represent all early childhood mental health providers in the county. Some agencies also provide adult mental health services. However, to maintain the directory’s focus on children, information regarding age ranges served by programs was capped at 18 years.

Agency information was provided directly by survey respondents and has not been verified. It is therefore recommended that professionals using the directory call the agencies to confirm the availability of services (e.g., culturally specific and/or free services) prior to making a referral.
