

Who is **Wraparound** for?

Wraparound is for children in Ramsey County Children's Mental Health Case Management who are experiencing severe emotional disturbances.

It is especially helpful for a child who is in more than one system of care and needs assistance to attain successful outcomes and build on natural supports.

What is **Wraparound**?

The **Wraparound** process is a way to support families by bringing together a team of people chosen by the family to help identify strengths and address the child's mental health issues.

It is a family-driven, culturally appropriate "Team approach" to attaining successful outcomes for children with mental health needs.

Who Can Be On the **Wraparound** Team?

Wraparound teams typically include people you know and trust involved in a child's life such as:

- friends
- neighbors
- family members
- relatives
- church members
- school staff and / or
- staff from appropriate agencies



Bringing together such a team to address barriers to a child's success is exciting and effective.

How To Set Up A **Wraparound** Team Meeting?

Ask a child's case manager to help set up a **Wraparound** team.

Together you can:

- select team members
- select a time that works for all team members, and
- set up the meeting

Who supports **Wraparound**?

The 35+ members of Ramsey County Children's Mental Health Collaborative, including parents, schools, providers, Ramsey County Children's Mental Health Case Management, and Corrections are all committed to making the **Wraparound** process work in Ramsey County.

The Ten Values of Wraparound

1. Individualized
2. Family Voice and Choice
3. Strength-based
4. Culturally competent
5. Team-based
6. Informal / Natural Supports Used
7. Collaborative
8. Community-based
9. Persistent
10. Outcome-based

Why does Wraparound have such wide support?

Because the Wraparound process has been successfully used nationwide for over 10 years.

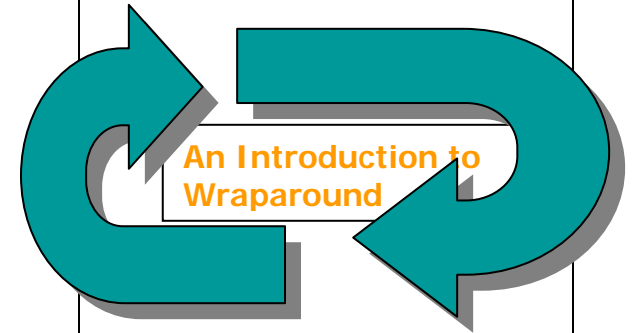
