Our Member Agencies Commit to Collaboration

- ✓ Update collaborative search tools at least once per year (*required*).
- ✓ Report waitlist details through a shared platform as often as possible.
- ✓ Notify RCCMHC when shared clients experience access barriers or need whole family supports.
- ✓ Participate in multi-provider Care Teams, consultations, cross-system resource sharing and two-way referrals with RCCMHC.
- ✓ Engage with community through RCCMHC resource fairs and family programs.
- ✓ Share expertise in multidisciplinary trainings and guide RCCMHC through committees and task groups

RCCMHC Supports Our Member Agencies

Marketing and Online Portal: Multisystem referral process, initial client outreach, and psychosocial screening to guide referrals.

Support for Staff: Navigaor App, waitlist table, case consultations, and other tools to help professionals serve families.

Resources for Shared Clients: Resource navigation, coordination for Care Teams, appointment reminders, transportation, flex funds, parent classes and youth skills groups.

Nonbillable Services Bank: Funding that covers costs associated with care team participation, consultation, no-shows, and connecting clients with whole family supports.

Professional Development: Monthly trainings with CEUs and access to a Professional Training and Scholarship Fund.

Evaluation and Data Support: Technical assistance, data collection, and reporting for shared client outcomes.
